Controller & Evaluator Duties

Assignments and additional training will be provided prior to the exercise

Controllers

- Set up and operate the exercise site
- Plan and manage exercise play
- Act in the roles of response individuals and agencies not playing in the exercise
- Controllers direct the pace of exercise play
- Manage injects
- Manage actors
- Manage venue safety

Evaluators

- Evaluate and provide feedback on a designated functional area of the exercise
- Assess and document participants' performance against established emergency plans and exercise evaluation criteria
- Evaluators play a passive role in the exercise and only note the actions of players; they do not interfere with the flow of the exercise
