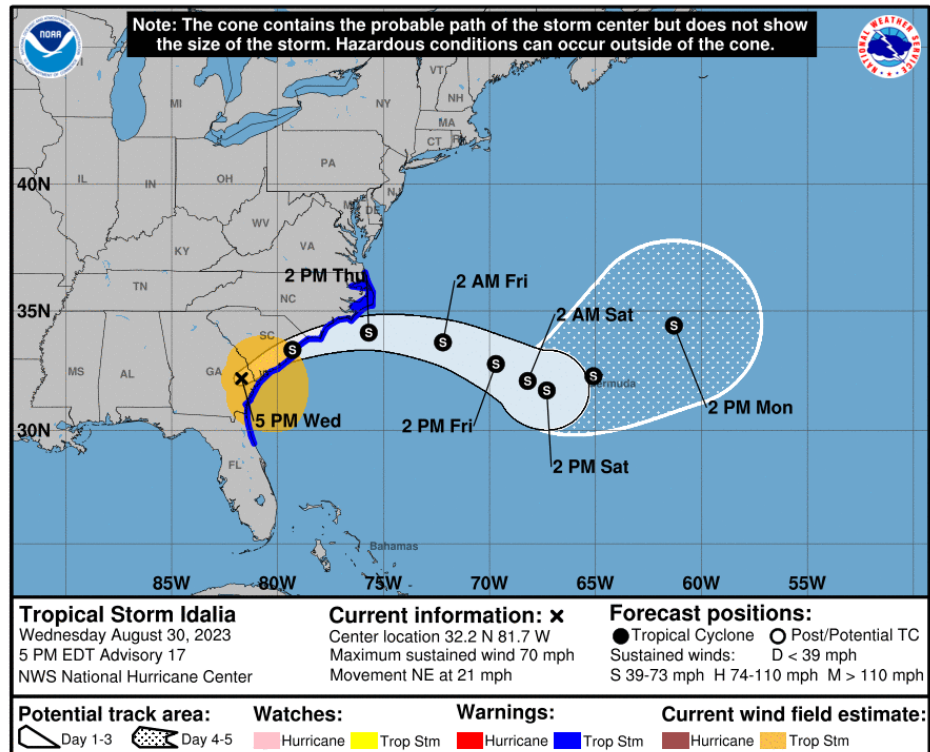


This Situation Report (SIT REP) is provided daily to the State ESF-8 Planning Section and distributed accordingly for situational awareness.

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Current Situation:

- The SEOC is activated at Level 1
- As of 5:00 PM EDT, Idalia is located about 40 miles west of Savannah, GA, 115 miles west-southwest of Charleston, SC, and is moving northeastward at 21 mph.
- Maximum sustained winds have weakened to 70 mph, making Idalia a tropical storm.
- Conditions have begun to improve for portions of Central Florida and across the Big Bend. Northeast Florida should see tropical storm conditions exit around sunset.
- A Flood Watch remains in effect for the eastern Suwannee River Valley and along the Florida Gulf Coast through this evening.

Emergency Medication Refills: Effective August 26, 2023 (EO 23-171 and 23-172), In accordance with section 465.0275(2), Florida Statutes, pharmacists may dispense up to a 30-day emergency prescription refill of maintenance medication to persons who reside in an area or county covered under this Executive Order and to emergency personnel who have been activated by their state or local agency but who do not reside in an area or county covered by this Executive Order. In accordance with section 465.019(4)(b), Florida Statutes, a hospital that operates a Class II or Class III institutional pharmacy located in an area or county covered under this Executive Order may prescribe and dispense a supply of a medicinal drug lasting up to 72 hours.
